

THE CROW FAMILY BOOK

Revised in June 1982

My book on the Crow family was compiled in 1963. At that time I knew of my great grandfather John Crow coming to Union Parish, Louisiana from Georgia. He is included in the 1860 census of Union Parish along with his wife and children. I also know that one of his sons George P. lived and died in Joaquin, Texas in 1933. I did not know anything about the other members of Martin Crow family (John's father).

We are aware of the Stroud family as Stephen and his brother, Isaac married Margaret and Elizabeth Stroud, daughters of John Stroud and the Crows and Strouds moved together from Virginia and North Carolina on to Georgia. In 1965 I learned that descendants of this John Stroud were living in Rusk County. I visited these people and learned of their Georgia origin.

As I visited Rusk County and Henderson particularly I began in 1979 to learn of Crows other than George of Joaquin had settled in the East Texas area. I visited a Mrs. John A. Simmons and found she is a descendant of John Washington Crow, son of John and brother of my grandfather William Marion. Mrs. Simmons's mother and father still live in John Washington's original home, well over 100 years old. They recall visits there from Jerusha and Mary, daughters of John Crow and sisters of John Washington.

I was fortunate to meet Mary Frank Dunn, who has done much research for me on the Crow and Stroud families of Rusk County. Records reveal 44 Crow marriages in that county between 1846 and 1890 therefore many more Crows resided there than in Union Parish.

Naturally I was pleased and amazed to find that as my great grandfather John settled in Louisiana several of his brothers, Joshua, Levi and Stephen and sister Serena were settling in Rusk County Texas, probably along with the Strouds mentioned above. Information regarding these Crows and certain census records are listed below.

In addition to John Washington moving from Louisiana to Rusk County apparently Isaac did also as his descendants are included in the Rusk County records.

Since 1963 my Crow book has gone to many descendants in most southern states and several western ones as well. I hear from these relatives as they learn from others of this information on the Crow family. Several have been able to piece together their family tree and like myself have enjoyed the knowledge they were seeking.

Among those who have written me in this regard includes a well known Dallas gentlemen, and world wide real estate developer, Trammell Crow. It has been a pleasure to meet him, his brother Davis and sisters Virginia and Kathleen. Davis is retired from a successful career with a major oil company and is active in commercial real estate. I have also enjoyed knowing Trammell's wife Margaret and several of their fine children, all of whom are active in Crow related businesses.

The Trammell Crow family descends from Thomas Douglas Crow who also lived in Rusk County along with Joshua, Levi and Stephen and the Strouds who Trammell advises were related to him on his fathers side. Their father Jefferson Brim Crow worked for John Parker in Monroe and while there married in 1907 Mary Inez Simonton of Choudrant, LA. This John Parker was a descendant of the Parkers of Georgia covered in my 1963 book on page 61.

It has been interesting to know this Crow family and information on them is included. By the location in Rusk County and common relationship to the Stroud family, Trammell and Davis have each remarked that their Thomas and Joshua, (and his brothers) obviously were closely related and maybe even brothers. (I make this statement with their permission).

On April 24, 1982 I sponsored a reunion at Henderson for the Crow and Stroud descendants and a few enjoyed a chance to get re-acquainted. The surprise to me is that so few Crows remain in the area, in fact only two Crows remain in the current Henderson telephone directory.

As other information is obtained I will be pleased to pass it onto the family.
